# FISCAL NOTE

Senate Bill 650 (Senator Haines) (Carroll County Delegation) Economic and Environmental Affairs

#### Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages (Employment of Minors)

This bill specifies the circumstances under which an alcoholic beverages licensee in Carroll County may hire minors. Class B licensees may employ a person 15 years or older to perform any task other than selling, serving, or delivering alcoholic beverages. In addition, a person 18 years or older may serve and sell alcoholic beverages in restaurants in connection with the serving and selling of a meal. The bill also prohibits a person under 21 years of age from acting as a bartender or barmaid or in any solely bar-related capacity.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**Local Effect:** None. Allowing alcoholic beverages licensees to hire minors to perform certain duties would not directly affect Carroll County finances.
