Senate Bill 760 (Senator Astle) Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Anne Arundel County - Wiley H. Bates High School (\$2,000,000)

This bill provides \$2,000,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the County Executive and County Council of Anne Arundel County for the renovation, reconstruction, and equipping of the Wiley H. Bates High School in Annapolis for use as a senior center, a community center, and other purposes.

Anne Arundel County must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998, and must also grant a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$2,000,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.

Local Effect: Anne Arundel County revenues would increase by \$2,000,000 and expenditures would increase by at least \$4,000,000.
