Transportation Facilities - Public-Private Partnerships

This joint resolution requests the Department of Transportation and the Maryland Transportation Authority to review the Consolidated Transportation Plan (CTP) and the Maryland Transportation Plan to identify projects that could be accelerated with private financing and develop policies and procedures for soliciting and establishing public-private partnership agreements for transportation systems and facilities.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The effect on the Transportation Trust Fund from entering into public-private partnerships would depend upon the terms of any such agreements. Compliance with the administrative requirements of this joint resolution could be handled with existing resources of the Department of Transportation and the Maryland Transportation Authority.
