House Bill 91 (Chairman, Commerce and Government Matters Committee) (Departmental - State Board of Elections) Commerce and Government Matters

Elections - Write-in Candidates

This departmental bill changes the deadline by which a write-in candidate must file a certificate of candidacy from 5:00 p.m. on the day preceding the election to 5:00 p.m. on the Wednesday preceding the election.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: County expenditures could decrease by an indeterminate minimal amount as discussed below. Revenues would not be affected.

Small Business Effect: The State Administrative Board of Election Laws has determined that this bill has no impact on small business (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: County governments could experience a minimal cost savings due to the longer time period for local elections boards to add write-in candidates' names to the ballots. With the expanded time, local elections boards may not need to hire as many part-time employees to perform this task. The amount of savings would depend upon the number of write-in candidates and the number of part-time employees who would be no longer needed to add the names to the ballots. Any cost savings cannot be reliably estimated at this time.
