### Medical Laboratories - Job-Related Alcohol and Controlled Dangerous Substance Testing

This bill requires the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH) to adopt regulations that require laboratories certified to conduct job-related alcohol or controlled dangerous substances testing to label each specimen with a number rather than a name.
