FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 301 (Delegate T. Murphy, et al.) Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Baltimore City - U.S.S. Sanctuary (\$900,000)

This bill provides \$900,000 in State bond revenues as a grant to the Board of Directors of Project Life, Inc. for the renovation and equipping of the former hospital ship, the U.S.S. Sanctuary, to provide residential educational programs for women and children with chemical dependencies.

The board must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998. The matching funds may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$900,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
