Economic Matters

Cosmetology - Waiver of Examination Requirement

This departmental bill clarifies that the Board of Cosmetology may waive an examination requirement for an applicant who is licensed to practice cosmetology in another state if the applicant has passed an examination which is equivalent to the State's examination.
