## FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 511 (Delegate Brinkley, et al.) Ways and Means

Inheritance Tax - Exemption for Property that Passes to Volunteer Fire, Rescue, and Emergency Medical Services Organizations

This bill exempts from the inheritance tax property passing to a volunteer fire, rescue, or emergency medical services organization in Maryland.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** Minimal indeterminate decrease in general fund revenues. Expenditures are not affected.

**Local Effect:** None.

## **Fiscal Analysis**

**State Revenues:** General fund revenues could decline a minimal amount in fiscal 1997 because property is seldom left to volunteer fire, rescue, or emergency medical services. If this bill induces individuals to leave more property to these organizations, the revenue loss could increase, though it would still be indeterminate.
