House Bill 581 (Charles County Delegation) Commerce and Government Matters

Charles County - County Appropriation to Physicians Memorial Hospital

This bill eliminates the requirement that the Charles County Commissioners appropriate at least \$8,500 annually to the Physicians Memorial Hospital. Instead, the bill provides the county commissioners with the option of appropriating any amount deemed necessary.

The bill is effective July 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Charles County expenditures would be minimally affected as discussed below.

Revenues would not be affected.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: Since the Charles County Commissioners would have discretion in setting the amount of funds provided to the Physician Memorial Hospital, any expenditure increase or decrease from the \$8,500 minimum funding requirement cannot be determined beforehand. It is expected, however, that any difference in funding would be minimal.
