House Bill 881 (Prince George's County Delegation)
Economic Matters

Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages
(23rd District - Sunday Sales)
PG 323-96

This bill makes the 23rd alcoholic beverages district in Prince George's County coterminous with the 23rd legislative district. The bill also permits Sunday sales of alcoholic beverages within the district by Class A (off-sale) licensees and by Class B beer, wine, and liquor licensees with off-sale privileges.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Allowing Sunday sales by certain alcoholic beverages licensees in the 23rd alcoholic beverages district would not directly affect Prince George's County finances. The bill applies to two Class A beer and light wine licensees and 13 Class A beer, wine, and liquor licensees.
