## Adults With Developmental Disabilities - Study of Services and Placements

This bill requires the State Board of Education and the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene to conduct a study of the services and placement of adults with developmental disabilities. The study is to include the extent to which individuals with developmental disabilities are denied appropriate services or placed in inappropriate settings when they are 21 years old or older. The State Board of Education and the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene are required to report their findings to the General Assembly by January 1, 1997.

This bill takes effect on June 1, 1996.
