House Bill 1251 (Chairman, Economic Matters Committee)
(Departmental - Labor, Licensing, and Regulation)

Economic Matters

Referred to Finance

Prevailing Wage Rates - Public Works Contracts - Annual Determinations

This amended departmental bill alters provisions of the law covering the finality of prevailing wage determinations to ensure that the rates remain in effect for one year from the date upon which the Commissioner of Labor and Industry issues the determination.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill would streamline the prevailing wage rate determination process and ensure that the rates issued by the Commissioner reflect current wages. However, the bill would not substantively alter State operations or finances and would have no fiscal impact.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: The Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment. (The attached assessment does not reflect amendments to the bill.)
