## **Insurance Commissioner - Enforcement Jurisdiction and Appeals Procedure**

This departmental bill clarifies that the Insurance Commissioner may enforce the Insurance Code against a person whose certificate of authority, certificate of qualification, license or registration is no longer in effect. In addition, the bill conforms the appeals procedures under the Insurance Code to comply with the Maryland Rules.
