**Insurance Commissioner - Enforcement Jurisdiction and Appeals Procedure**

---

This enrolled departmental bill provides that the Insurance Commissioner may enforce the Insurance Code against a person whose certificate of authority, certificate of qualification, license or registration is no longer in effect if the alleged violation occurred no more than five years before the surrender or lapse of the certificate, license, or registration. In addition, the bill conforms the appeals procedures under the Insurance Code to comply with the Maryland Rules.

**Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill would not substantively impact the operations or finances of the Maryland Insurance Administration.
