FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

Senate Bill 431 (Senator Baker, et al.) Budget and Taxation

Creation of a State Debt - Cecil County - Union Hospital (\$1,200,000)

This bill provides \$1,200,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Board of Directors of Union Hospital, Inc. for the construction and equipping of an expanded birthing center to be located at 106 Bow Street in Cecil County.

The board must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998. The funds may consist of funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$1,200,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
