Commerce and Government Matters

Election Laws - Polling Places - Electioneering

This departmental bill repeals current law which prohibits electioneering activities within a 300 foot radius of polling places in Anne Arundel, Cecil, Charles, Garrett, Harford, Kent, and Queen Anne's counties.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Any loss in fine revenues would be insignificant.

Local Effect: None. Any loss in fine revenues or savings in detention costs would be insignificant.

Small Business Effect: The State Administrative Board of Election Laws has determined that this bill has no impact on small business (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment.
