House Bill 142 (Delegate Stup, et al.) Environmental Matters

Tobacco Products - Illegal Distribution to Minors

This bill prohibits persons engaged in the business of distributing tobacco products from distributing any tobacco product, cigarette rolling papers, or a coupon redeemable for any tobacco product to a minor. Under current law, these persons are prohibited from purchasing these items for or selling these items to minors. A law enforcement officer authorized to make arrests shall issue a civil citation to a person if the officer believes a violation of these provisions has occurred.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Enforcement of these provisions can be handled with existing resources. Revenues could increase by a minimal amount under current penalty provisions.

Local Effect: Revenues could increase a minimal amount under current penalty provisions. Expenditures would not be affected.
