## FISCAL NOTE Revised

House Bill 502 (Chairman, Environmental Matters Committee) (Departmental - Environment)

#### Water Quality - Grants and Loans for Projects - Expansion

This enrolled departmental bill provides that phosphorus removal projects are eligible for wastewater treatment construction grants and loans if undertaken in conjunction with a nitrogen removal cost-share grant. Currently, these funds are used for nitrogen removal projects.

### **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. The bill alters the purposes for which State-granted moneys can be spent but does not affect the overall amount of money loaned or granted through the program.

**Local Effect:** The overall level of funding available for local governments will not be affected. The bill will result in a reallocation of funding for projects submitted by local government units. There are currently 64 major wastewater treatment plants targeted to be upgraded for nitrogen and phosphorous removal; 17 of these have already been upgraded.

**Small Business Effect:** The Department of Environment has determined that this bill has minimal or no impact on small business (attached). Fiscal Services concurs with this assessment as discussed below.

# **Fiscal Analysis**

**Small Business Effect:** All of the facilities that would be impacted by this legislation are units of local government. Therefore, this bill has no effect on small business.
