State Buildings - Pictures of Abducted Children

This enrolled bill requires the Department of General Services (DGS), the Department of Transportation (DOT), and the University of Maryland System (UMS) to reserve space in State buildings under their control so that specified groups may display pictures of abducted children.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill would not require any additional expenditures, unless regulations adopted by the Board of Public Works require State entities to put up special bulletin boards for the display of pictures. In that event, any additional expenditures would be minimal and could be absorbed by existing resources.
