House Bill 1252 (Delegate Minnick)

Economic Matters

Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Alcoholic Beverages - Class 5 Licenses
(Tasting and Selling Privileges)

This amended bill allows a Class 5 brewery licensee to serve and sell beer brewed at the premises to any individual who has taken a guided tour of the brewery, if the individual is of legal drinking age. The serving size cannot exceed 6 ounces and the purchase is limited to 144 ounces of beer per person annually.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Allowing a Class 5 brewery to serve and sell certain volumes of beer at the brewery would not directly affect State finances.
