## **Residential Mortgages - Interest on Escrow Accounts**

This bill repeals the exemption from required interest on escrow account payments by out-of-state lenders who purchase first mortgage loans on residential real property through the Federal National Mortgage Association, the Government National Mortgage Association, or the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation when the lender has elected to service the loan as a condition of payment.

The bill applies to all subject loans that are in existence on, or are made after, October 1, 1996.
