Senate Bill 232 (Senator Lawlah) Finance

Commercial Law - Payment by Check - Request for Credit Card Prohibited

This bill prohibits a person from requesting the display of a credit card as a condition of accepting a check as payment for consumer credit, goods, realty, or services. The bill limits allowable exceptions to instances where the person requesting the information has an agreement with the issuer of the credit card to cash checks for cardholders and the issuer guarantees payment of the cardholder's checks.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Assuming that the Consumer Protection Division will receive fewer than 50 complaints per year stemming from this bill, existing resources should be adequate to handle any additional workload.
