Motor Vehicle Administration -Chesapeake Bay Commemorative License Plate Program - Extension

This enrolled bill extends the Chesapeake Bay commemorative license plate program to July 1, 1998. The bill is effective June 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: Chesapeake Bay and Endangered Species Fund and Transportation Trust Fund revenues and expenditures would continue until July 1, 1998.

Local Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

State Effect: Chesapeake Bay and Endangered Species Fund revenues of approximately \$500,000 annually would be maintained, offset by grants awarded by the Chesapeake Bay Trust. Transportation Trust Fund revenues of approximately \$333,000 annually would also be maintained, offset by production costs for the special vehicle license plates.
