Financial Institutions - Automated Teller Machines -Study of the Feasibility of Listing Fees for Usage

This amended bill requires the Office of the Bank Commissioner to study the technological feasibility of listing on an automated teller machine's screen the amount of the fee to be charged for using the machine. The Bank Commissioner must report the results of the study to the General Assembly by December 31, 1996.

The bill is effective June 1, 1996.
