FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 493 (Washington County Delegation)
Commerce and Government Matters

Washington County - Election Judges - Salaries

This bill increases the election day compensation of election judges in Washington County. The compensation for a chief judge increases from \$75 to \$100, while the compensation of a regular judge increases from \$65 to \$80. These changes are effective at the beginning of the next term of office.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Washington County expenditures would increase by \$5,620 in FY 1997, and in each election year thereafter. Revenues would not be affected.

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: Washington County expenditures would increase by \$5,620 in fiscal 1997 due to the salary increases for 94 chief judges and 218 regular judges. This estimate reflects the salary increase of \$25 for chief judges and \$15 for regular judges. Out-year expenditures would increase by an equal amount in each election year.
