## Workers' Compensation - Independent Contractors Receiving Compensation From Farmers for Service - Not Covered Employees

This amended bill provides that an individual, other than a migrant farm worker, who receives compensation from a farmer for services is not a covered employee entitled to workers' compensation benefits if: (1) the individual is engaged in an independent business occupation of the same nature as the service performed; (2) the individual uses his/her own equipment, materials, and tools; (3) the individual directs his/her own performance; and (4) the farmer is not required to withhold taxes from the individual's compensation.
