House Bill 763 (Delegate Hubbard, et al.)
Appropriations

Creation of a State Debt - Prince George's County - Patuxent 4-H Foundation
(\$150,000)

This bill provides \$150,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Patuxent 4-H Center, Inc. for the completion of construction and equipping of a cabin in Upper Marlboro to be used for overnight accommodations and programs for youth groups.

The Patuxent 4-H Center must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998. The funds may consist of real property, in kind contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of the bill.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: This \$150,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.
