FISCAL NOTE

House Bill 803 (Prince George's County Delegation)
Economic Matters

Prince George's County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Compensation of Inspectors)
PG 307-96

This bill increases the minimum annual salary of the 29 part-time alcoholic beverages inspectors in Prince George's County from \$9,270 to \$10,000, or by \$730 each.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Prince George's County expenditures would increase by \$20,641 in FY 1997. Revenues would not be affected. **This bill imposes a mandate on a unit of local government.**

Fiscal Analysis

Local Expenditures: Prince George's County expenditures would increase by \$20,641 in fiscal 1997, which reflects the October 1, 1996 effective date. This estimate consists of \$15,878 in salaries and \$4,763 in fringe benefits. Annualized, the costs would be \$27,521. One cent on the county's property tax rate yields approximately \$1,666,630 in fiscal 1997. Accordingly, this \$20,641 expenditure increase will have a negligible impact on the county's property tax rate.
