House Bill 1463 (Frederick County Delegation)
Judiciary

Frederick County - Special Deputy Sheriffs

This emergency bill authorizes the Frederick County Sheriff to appoint as special deputy sheriffs certain investigators with the county's State's Attorney's Office. These investigators must have achieved at least the minimum level of training for police duties as designated by the Maryland Police Training Commission.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Authorizing the Frederick County Sheriff to appoint investigators as deputy sheriffs would not directly affect county finances. It is assumed that any potential tort liability claims against investigators acting as deputy sheriffs would be settled in amounts below the county's insurance coverage limits.
