## **Property Tax Relief - Potomac Conservancy**

This enrolled bill authorizes local governments to grant a property tax credit for property owned by the Potomac Conservancy that is used for one of the following purposes: 1) to assist in the preservation of a natural area; 2) for the environmental education of the public; 3) generally to promote conservation; and 4) for the maintenance of a natural area for public use or a sanctuary for wildlife.

The bill is effective June 1, 1996, and applies to all taxable years beginning after June 30, 1996.

## **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None.

**Local Effect:** Assuming Montgomery County authorizes a tax credit, local revenues could decrease by approximately \$1,000 beginning in FY 1997. All property currently owned by the Potomac Conservancy is located on flood plains in Montgomery County and thus has a very low tax assessment. However, to the extent that the conservancy acquires developable land in the future, the loss could be larger.
