Preventive Services Task Force

This amended bill requires the Health Services Cost Review Commission (HSCRC) and the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DHMH) to establish a 12-member Preventive Services Task Force to study the feasibility of establishing a preventive services program for individuals likely to generate uncompensated care in the absence of preventive services. The task force is to report its findings by November 1, 1996 to the Governor and the General Assembly.

The bill takes effect July 1, 1996 and sunsets June 30, 1997.
