Senate Bill 603 (Senator Astle) Finance

Insurance - Coverage for Carbon Monoxide Injuries and Damage in Multifamily Rental Dwellings

This bill requires a contract for insurance covering a multifamily rental dwelling that is issued or renewed after July 1, 1996 to provide liability coverage for personal injury and property damage resulting from carbon monoxide discharge from a heating, ventilation, air-conditioning, or refrigeration system located in an enclosed space.

The bill is effective July 1, 1996.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: General fund revenues would increase by about \$10,000 in FY 1997 only due to one-time filing fees collected by the Maryland Insurance Administration. Expenditures would not be affected.

Local Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

State Revenues: Approximately 50 insurers writing commercial property insurance would submit revised rate and form filings to the Maryland Insurance Administration and pay a \$100 form filing fee and \$100 rate filing fee. As a result, general fund revenues would increase by \$10,000 in fiscal 1997. Future year revenues would not be affected.
