Economic Matters

Uniform Commercial Code - Negotiable Instruments - Revision

This bill adopts the revised Title 3 of the Uniform Commercial Code relating to negotiable instruments. A statute of limitations for actions arising under Title 3 is provided. The bill also amends Title 4 relating to bank deposits and collections so as to provide for truncation agreements between banks, a statute of limitations, and designated warranties.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. While this bill makes substantive changes in specified Uniform Commercial Code statutes, it does not substantively change governmental activities or operations.
