Economic Matters Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Home Improvement Commission - Sunset Extension

This enrolled bill extends the sunset date for provisions of the Business Regulation Article related to the Home Improvement Commission from October 1, 1996 to October 1, 2002 and requires an evaluation of the Home Improvement Committee on or before October 1, 2001.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: State finances for the Home Improvement Commission in the Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing would continue in FY 1997 as discussed below.

Local Effect: None.

Fiscal Analysis

State Revenues: State revenues will be maintained because the bill proposes to continue the Home Improvement Commission. The fiscal 1997 appropriation includes \$2.4 million in general fund revenues for this commission.

State Expenditures: State expenditures will be maintained because the bill proposes to continue the Home Improvement Commission. The fiscal 1997 appropriation includes \$1.6 million in general fund expenditures for this commission. Out-year expenditures are expected to remain relatively constant.
