## FISCAL NOTE Bond Bill

House Bill 564 (Delegate Exum, et al.) Appropriations

## Creation of a State Debt - Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission - Snow Hill Manor (\$250,000)

This bill provides \$250,000 in State bond proceeds as a grant to the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission (M-NCPPC) for the renovation and equipping of the Snow Hill Manor.

The M-NCPPC must provide matching funds by June 1, 1998, and must also grant a perpetual preservation easement to the Maryland Historical Trust.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** This \$250,000 bond authorization would be part of the total \$400 million general obligation debt authorization for fiscal 1997 as recommended by the Capital Debt Affordability Committee. State debt service costs on the \$400 million would be a maximum of \$41.3 million annually based on an interest rate of 4.51%.

**Local Effect:** M-NCPPC revenues would increase by \$250,000 and expenditures would increase by at least \$500,000.
