**Vehicle Laws - Combination of a Power Unit and a Travel Trailer - Length
Limitations**

This enrolled bill extends the maximum authorized length of a combination of noncommercial vehicles consisting of a power unit and a travel trailer from 55 to 60 feet. A combination of vehicles in excess of 55 feet in length may only be operated on (1) the interstate highway system; (2) a highway that is the shortest practical route to a point of origin or designation; or (3) a highway for a distance not to exceed one mile for food, fuel, repairs, or rest.
