State Blue Ribbon Commission on Summer Youth Employment

This emergency bill establishes an 11-member State Blue Ribbon Commission on Summer Youth Employment, appointed by the Governor, to formulate a plan to create summer job opportunities for youth in 1996. The Commission is required to report its findings and recommendation to the Governor and the General Assembly by April 30, 1996. The bill terminates after that date.

Staffing will be provided by the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The staffing requirements of this bill can be handled with the existing budgeted resources of the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation. Expense reimbursements are assumed to be minimal and absorbable within existing executive branch resources.
