## **FISCAL NOTE**

House Bill 1044 (Washington County Delegation) Commerce and Government Matters

## **Washington County - Electrician Licenses**

This bill alters the passing grade for the Master Electrician examination in Washington County by providing that a passing grade is 75% rather than 70%. The bill alters the fee for a Master Electrician or a Restricted Electrician by providing that the fee for an initial license or the reactivation of an inactive license must be prorated by the number of years remaining in the license.

In addition, the bill alters the requirements for a Restricted Electrician license, establishes eight categories of Restricted Electrician licenses, and provides that a licensed Restricted Electrician may install electrical wiring from the point of distribution to the equipment or appliance.

## **Fiscal Summary**
