House Bill 1214 (Delegate Poole) Commerce and Government Matters

Referred to Judicial Proceedings

Vehicle Laws - Vehicle Dealer Franchises and Manufacturers, Distributors, and Factory Branches

This amended bill prohibits a vehicle manufacturer, distributor, or factory branch from requiring or coercing a dealer (1) to materially change a dealer's facilities or method of conducting business if the change would result in financial hardship; (2) to eliminate a dealership for which the dealer has a franchise agreement to utilize the facilities as of March 1, 1996; or (3) to adhere to performance standards that are not applied uniformly to other similarly situated dealers. The bill also prohibits a franchise agreement from containing any provision requiring a dealer to pay attorney's fees incurred by the manufacturer, distributor, or factory branch for disputes involving the franchise.

The bill establishes procedures for a dealer to designate the successor of a dealership to certain persons in the event of the death or incapacity of the dealer. The bill provides that a dealer, designated dealer successor, manufacturer, distributor, or factory branch may request a hearing to resolve a dispute.
