House Bill 1384 (Delegate Flanagan) Judiciary

## Personal Injury Actions - Subrogated Medical Expenses - Reduction

This bill reduces the amount that a health insurer can recover for benefits paid to an injured party if the injured party recovers damages through a cause of action against a liable party. If a health insurer exercises its rights of subrogation, the insurer can recover the benefits paid to the injured party less an amount based on a specific formula to reflect the attorney fees incurred by the injured party to bring the cause of action.
