**Administrative Hearings - Service of Notice**

---

This bill provides that an agency may serve a hearing notice on a former licensee by sending the notice by regular mail to the last known business and home address of the former licensee if (1) the notice has been sent within three years of the termination of the person's license; and (2) the agency has been unsuccessful in giving notice in the manner otherwise provided by the licensing statute.

A person served by regular mail, as provided by this bill, will be granted a hearing after showing that the person neither knew nor had reasonable opportunity to know of the fact of service.
