Howard County - Sunday Blue Laws - Car Dealers Ho. Co. 9-96

This bill allows car dealers in Howard County to sell or offer to sell motor vehicles on Sunday.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None, as discussed below.

Local Effect: None. Allowing car dealers to be open for business on Sunday would not directly affect Howard County finances.

Fiscal Analysis

State Revenues: Although the bill allows car dealers in Howard County to sell or offer to sell vehicles on Sunday, it is not expected to significantly increase the total number of cars sold in the State. While it is possible that the number of cars sold in Howard County could increase, this increase would likely be offset by decreases in car sales in the surrounding counties. Accordingly, State revenues would not be affected.
