**Office on Aging - Crimes Involving Moral Turpitude -
Suspension or Revocation of Certificates**

This amended bill authorizes the Office on Aging to deny, suspend, or revoke the certification of applicants or providers of sheltered housing for the elderly when the applicant or provider has been convicted of or has plead guilty or nolo contendere to a crime involving moral turpitude. When an applicant or provider has a pending criminal case for a crime involving moral turpitude, the office must withhold its decision until there has been a final disposition of the case.
