## Prevailing Wage Law - Exemption for Construction of a Professional Football Stadium in Baltimore City

This bill provides an exemption from Maryland's prevailing wage law for any public works contract associated with the construction of a professional football stadium at Camden Yards in Baltimore City.

## **Fiscal Summary**

**State Effect:** None. Construction for the professional football stadium at Camden Yards in Baltimore City will be contracted through the Maryland Stadium Authority. The Financial Institutions Article exempts the Maryland Stadium Authority from Division II of the State Finance and Procurement Article, which includes the State's prevailing wage law. Therefore, this bill has no impact.
