House Bill 295 (Delegate V. Mitchell, et al.)

Workers' Compensation - Domestic Servant - Minimum Earnings

This enrolled bill provides that an employer of a domestic servant is not required to purchase workers' compensation insurance unless the domestic servant earns at least \$750 per quarter. Under current law the earnings threshold is \$250 per quarter.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. Eliminating workers' compensation requirements for these employees would not affect State agency funding or operations.
