House Bill 1015 (Prince George's County Delegation) Ways and Means

Prince George's County Board of Education - Appeals PG 403-96

This bill enables the Prince George's County Board of Education or a designated committee of board members to hear appeals from a decision of the County Superintendent relating to a student's grades, transfer, tuition, or participation in school programs and activities. The legislation does not apply to cases involving students with disabilities.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. Since decisions of the Superintendent can already be appealed to the entire county board, enabling the county board to delegate its review powers to a subcommittee will not affect county finances.
