House Bill 1175 (Chairman, Economic Matters Committee) (Departmental - Labor, Licensing and Regulation)

Economic Matters

Professional Land Surveyors, Professional Engineers, and Architects - Responsible Charge

This departmental bill redefines the term "responsible charge" by providing that a professional engineer, land surveyor, and architect must maintain (1) direct knowledge and control; (2) regular supervision; (3) substantive review; and (4) authority to make revisions. In addition, the bill clarifies the definition of "responsible member" by providing that a responsible member includes a partner of a partnership.

Fiscal Summary
