House Bill 1325 (Cecil County Delegation)

Economic Matters

Referred to Economic and Environmental Affairs

Cecil County - Alcoholic Beverages
(Special and Temporary Licenses)

This amended bill allows the Chairman of the Board of License Commissioners in Cecil County, with the oral or written approval of a majority of the board, to grant special licenses of any class, except manufacturer's and wholesaler's licenses. The bill also repeals the requirement that the board provide notice of a special license application.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: Allowing the chairman to grant special licenses under certain circumstances would not directly affect Cecil County finances. Similarly, any cost savings resulting from the repeal of the notification requirement would be minimal.
