House Bill 1415 (The Speaker)

Commerce and Government Matters

Referred to Budget and Taxation

Council on Management and Productivity

This amended bill creates a 25-member Council on Management and Productivity in the Department of Budget and Fiscal Planning. The members must include representatives of labor, local government, and non-profit organizations. Among other responsibilities, the council is to solicit suggestions for innovative ways for the State to operate more efficiently while maintaining quality, review the organization and management of State government, and evaluate public-private partnership alternatives regarding State programs and State-owned real property. The council shall submit annually by August 30 to the General Assembly, the Legislative Policy Committee, and the Governor a report concerning its activities and recommendations. The council shall terminate by June 30, 2002. The bill also repeals provisions regarding the Efficiency 2000 Commission.

Fiscal Summary
