## **Patuxent Institution**

This amended departmental bill tightens the criteria for admission to the Patuxent Institution Youth Program and removes the ability of a judge to refer persons to the Institution's traditional ("eligible person") program who are convicted of first degree murder, first degree rape, or first degree sexual offense.
